Apply

To qualify for WellCare's Community Connections Resource Grant (CCRG), an organization must address the following social service programming:

COVID-19 Topics: Financial Assistance-Infant Formula, Homeless/Housing, Rent Assistance, Social Isolation, Transportation-delivery of diapers(children and adults), Transportation-delivery of food, and Utility Assistance.

Organizations must have a nonprofit 501(c)(3) status in Georgia to apply for a CCRG. Complete the Level 1 Application Form and email it to

GA_CommunityConnections@wellcare.com.

CCRG applications are accepted from **April 1, 2020 to April 15, 2020**.



Applicants must answer all of the questions and select designated Georgia health topics in order to be considered.

Awards

WellCare's CCRG will be awarded in amounts of \$500, \$1,000, and \$1,500. Awardees will be notified both over the phone and in writing if they have been selected to receive a grant. Funds will be distributed once required paperwork has been received by the Community Engagement Team. Awards do not involve reporting or administrative follow-up after award is received.

What are the requirements to apply for a CCRG?

Organizations must be based in Georgia and be registered as a nonprofit 501(c)(3) to apply for a CCRG.

How long does the CCRG process take?

The period for accepting grant applications is from **April 1, 2020–April 15, 2020**.

Awardees will be notified within **15** days after the application closing period.



How To Complete The Level 1 Application Form

- 1 Open the Level 1 Application Form.
- 2 Respond to all questions in the fields provided.
- 3 Please type "N/A" in any fields as indicated.
- 4 Please be sure to fill out the application accurately and completely. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
 - a. **Organization's Mission** – Please include your organization's mission statement, vision statement, and/or one or two sentences about the purpose behind your organization.
 - b. **Requested Amount** – Please enter the grant amount you are requesting. Requests ranging from \$500-\$1500.
 - c. **Description of Grant** – Please provide 3-5 sentences describing the initiative you hope to fund with your Resource Grant and the anticipated impact of the award to your organization.
 - d. **Objective(s)** – Please describe what you hope to achieve through the CCRG, and the measurable outcomes you hope to see as a result.

- 6 An automatic response email will serve as your confirmation that your email was received.
